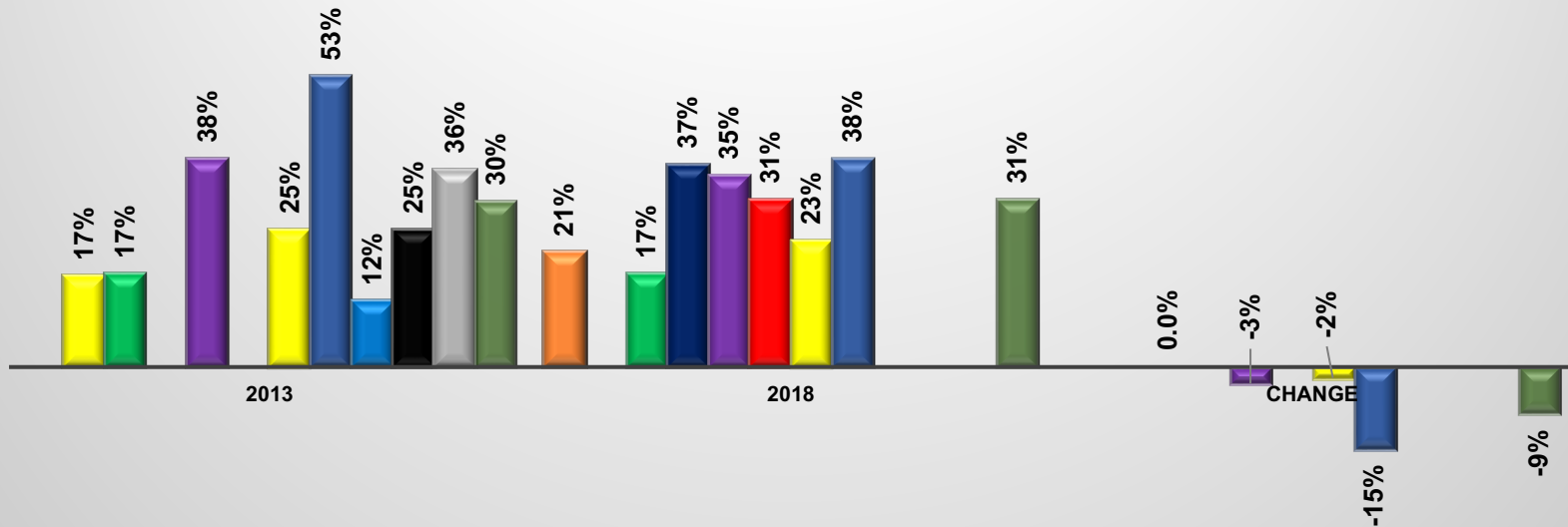

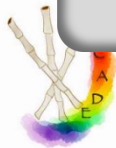
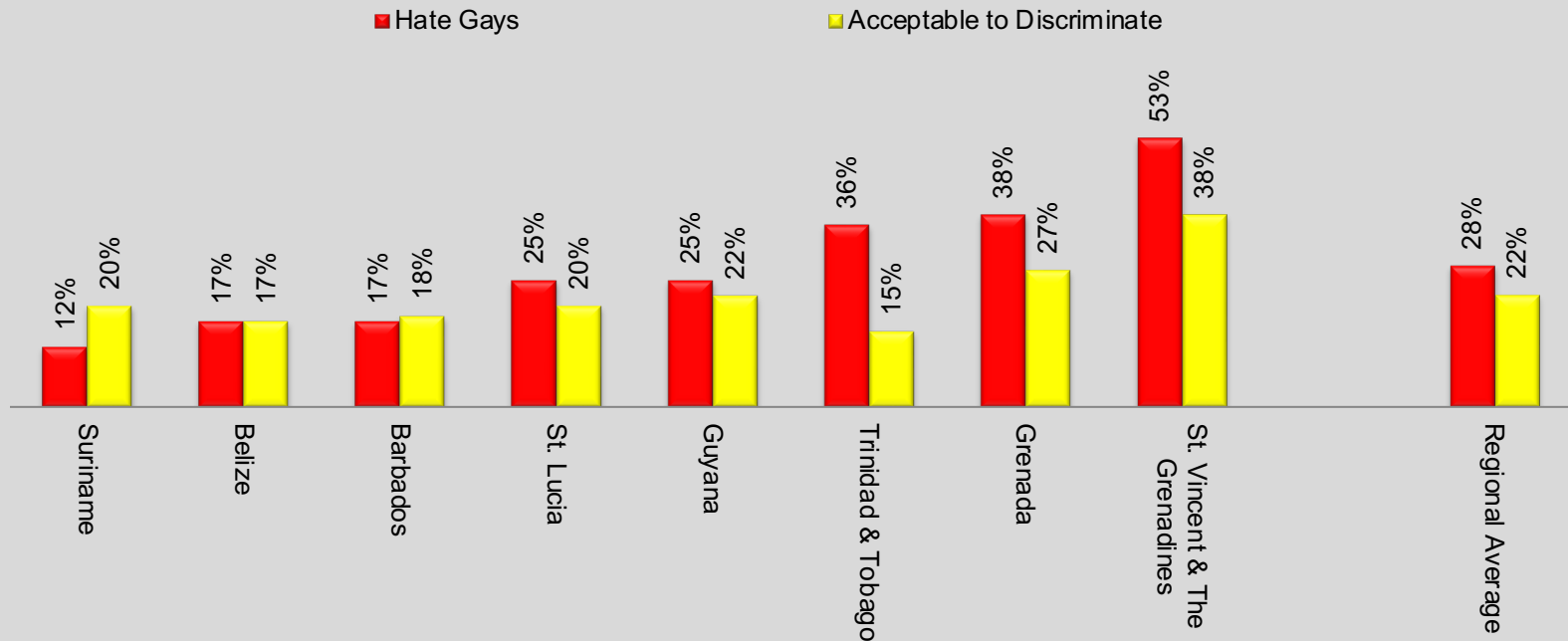
Is Violence Against Sexual Minorities Discrimination?

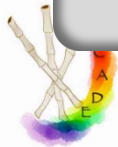
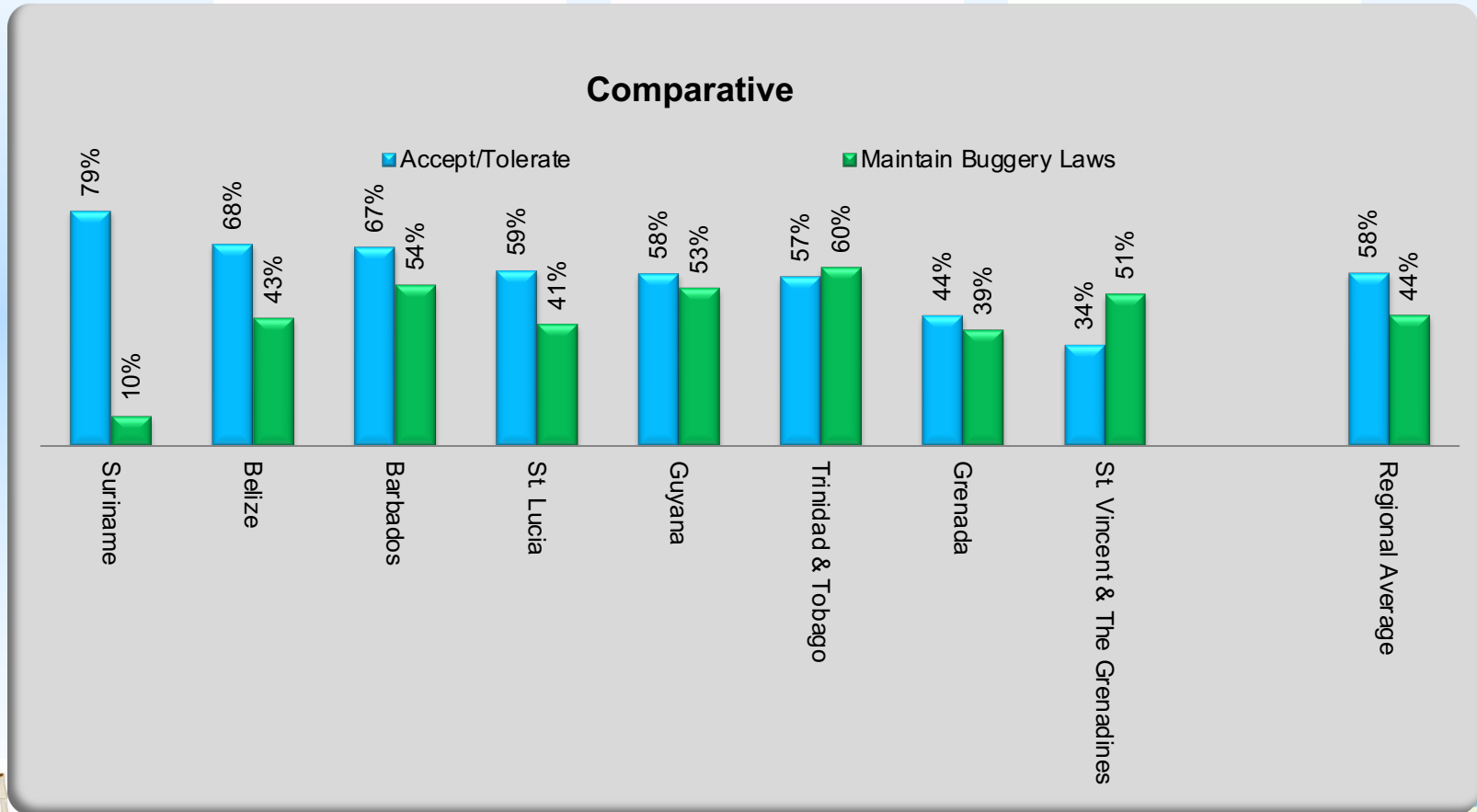
Hate Gays Versus Acceptable to Discriminate
(On the basis of Sexual Orientation)



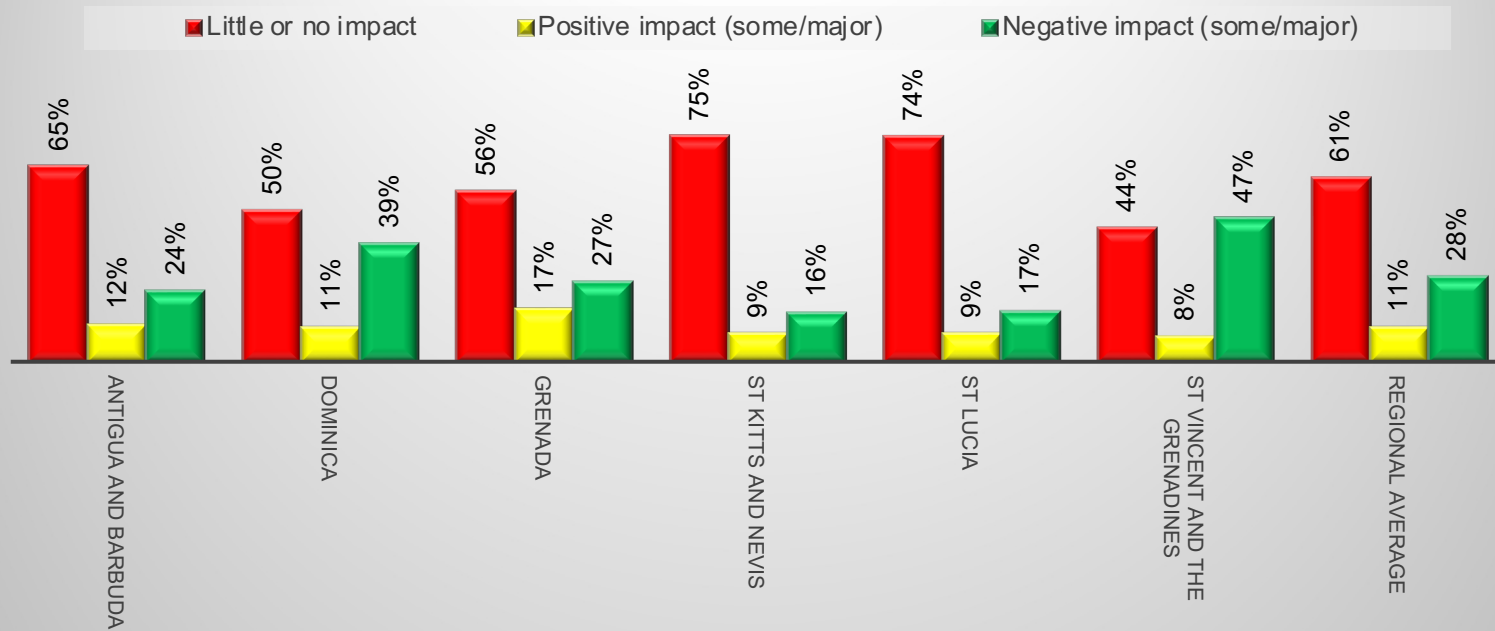


Attitude Towards Existing and Future Legislation

Summary of Focus Group Findings

DOMINANT CHRISTIAN VALUES

Featured Christian beliefs as guiding principles for morality (with varying degrees of intensity)

“Hate the sin and not the sinner”; FGs generally claimed no opposition to LGBT people, but just as quick to assert that they did not “agree with” LGBT lifestyles.



LGBTQI IN SOCIETY

Felt strongly against feeling forced to accept LGBT lifestyles, via popular media, proposed changes to legislation or via any other changes to their value system.

Felt everyone in their country should have the right to live, work and contribute to the economic prosperity of the nation, regardless of sexual orientation or any other factors.
